To Whom It May Concern,

Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (AGT) owns and operates a natural gas pipeline and two associated compressor stations in southeastern New York. This notice is to inform you that a planned natural gas release may occur at the Southeast Compressor Station on May 2, 2023. AGT is planning to perform maintenance which may result in natural gas venting. Algonquin will make every effort to minimize the volume of gas released by using recompression equipment at the site to significantly reduce the amount of gas vented.

This planned maintenance may release more than 10,000 standard cubic feet of natural gas and will vent through facilities specifically designed to safely vent natural gas. The venting may be heard by our neighbors. While there will be no risk to the public, Enbridge has notified local public safety officials in the event they receive any calls or questions.

Pipelines are the safest, most efficient, and most reliable way to transport energy resources. Pipelines play a vital role in our everyday lives and are essential to our quality of life and economy—moving the products necessary for transportation, heating and cooling our homes, generating electricity, producing our food supply, and manufacturing consumer products.

Enbridge's top priority is operating our pipeline network safely. Our pipelines meet or exceed rigorous regulatory standards, and we work diligently to protect our pipeline network, because it means our neighbors and employees are protected as well.
